## Minutes

Friends of the Lincoln Public Library Annual Meeting November 23, 2024 Willow Room, 11:30 a.m. - 1:10 p.m. [for approval on December 10, 2024]

Doors opened at 11:00 a.m. and lunch was catered by Sourdough & Co. (12 Bridges location). The meeting started at 11:30.

- I. Call to Order: President Teresa Lai Stanislaw called the meeting to order.
- II. Welcome/Introductions Teresa opened the meeting by welcoming 34 members and thanking them for attending. She then introduced Library Director Kathryn Hunt.
- III. Kathryn Hunt spoke about how vital "friends" organizations are to the library community in general and specifically how important FOLL is to the Lincoln Public Library. Kathryn pointed out that FOLL is an all-volunteer entity including board members and how we support activities such as Family Movie Night, Family Art Night, Mother Goose on the Loose, etc. The library has an average of 250,000 library visits per year equivalent to 5 visits per each Lincoln resident. Volunteers provide about 1,000 hours each month in library operations assistance. She thanked FOLL and the members, donors and supporters.
- IV. Treasurer Gloria Pilotti-Irey gave a presentation on our financial status including revenue, expenses, major purchases of check-out stations and the book locker for 2024 and offered 2025 plans including new furniture for the children's area. Gloria also reviewed the accounting procedures in place to ensure we follow good fiduciary practices. Members were advised that FOLL would be receiving \$200,000 of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds from the City of Lincoln and that FOLL has entered into a

Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the City to use the funds for library infrastructure improvements and community outreach equipment and materials.

V. Vice President Dawna Hawksworth provided a total vote count of 49 for the 2025 elections, confirmed a quorum was met and introduced the following incoming board members:
