Enhancing Delivery of Library Services

The Lincoln Public Library is always looking for ways to better serve our community and, in 2024, the library did just that with our financial help. The installation of hold lockers at the library and Lincoln Community Center and new self check-out stations make it easier for library users to access the 113,000 books and media available at the library. Spanish language speakers now have the option to access the library catalog in Espanol and patrons interested in gardening can pick up seeds and information at the new Seed Library.
